


The grievance regarding the charge to accruals during emergency weather pursuant to the Stipulation of Agreement dated January 30, 2019, AAA Case Number, 01-21-0016-4194, is settled between the Yonkers City School District, the Board of Education of the Yonkers City School District (collectively referred to as the "District") and the Civil Service Employees Association, Inc. Local 1000, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, Westchester Local 860 Yonkers Non-Teaching Unit #9169 ("CSEA") according to the following terms:

1. Any CSEA member working in Central Office who was not called in to work on February 1, 2021, is currently employed in the district and had a sick, vacation or personal day accrual deducted will have that accrual restored provided that the member did not previously call in sick or otherwise give notice of intent to use a sick, personal or vacation day on February 1, 2021 prior to the declaration of a state of emergency at 11:00am.
2. Any CSEA member working in Central Office who called in sick or gave notice of the intent to use a sick, personal or vacation day on February 1, 2021, prior to the state of emergency being declared at 11:00am on that day will not have the accrual restored.

This agreement shall be effective upon approval by the Board of Education.
