

## REGULAR MEETINGS

In order to perform its duties in an open and public manner, and in accordance with state law, the Board of Education shall hold regular business meetings once a month (“Stated Meetings”).

Notification of all meetings shall be given to the media at least 72 hours before the meeting. In the event of an emergency, notification will be given to the extent practicable.

In the event that the day appointed for a Stated Meeting falls on a legal holiday, the meeting shall be rescheduled. All regular Board meetings are open to the public.

In addition to the members of the Board, the following individuals will regularly attend the business meetings of the Board: the Superintendent of Schools, and other specified personnel as deemed necessary.

Adjournment to a later date may be made by a majority vote of the Board at the meeting. The Board may reschedule a Stated meeting by a majority vote of the Board taken in a public meeting.
