ORDER OF MERGER

This Instrument Witnesseth That the Board of Regents for and on behalf of the Education Department of the State of New York at their meeting of July 13, 2020.

The Westchester School for Special Children, located in Yonkers, county of Westchester and state of New York, was incorporated by the Board of Regents under a provisional charter on February 25, 1983 and made absolute on May 23, 1986.

Westchester Exceptional Children, Inc., located in the county of Westchester, and state of New York, was incorporated pursuant to the provisions of the Not-for-Profit Corporation Law (NPCL) on November 13, 1970.

The boards of trustees of The Westchester School for Special Children and Westchester Exceptional Children, Inc., have petitioned the Board of Regents, pursuant to Education Law §223, for an order to merge the said corporations under one name, to wit, The Westchester School for Special Children, in accordance with an agreement of merger annexed to the petition, with power to carry on and conduct the educational activities heretofore carried on and conducted by said petitioners, and it was

Voted, that

1. Pursuant to the authority contained in Education Law §223, The Westchester School for Special Children and Westchester Exceptional Children, Inc. be, and hereby are, merged under the name The Westchester School for Special Children.

2. The principal office of the merged corporation shall be located at 45 Park Avenue Yonkers, New York 10703.

3. The Westchester School for Special Children, the surviving corporation, will continue to administer the educational operations and purposes of the constituent corporations in the same manner as they presently exist, and the purposes of the merged surviving corporation are restated as follows

To provide, staff, administer, operate and maintain a school providing instructional services for handicapped children, and

a. to promote the general welfare of autistic children at home, in the community, in institutions, and in public, private and religious schools;

b. to further the advancement of all ameliorative and preventative study and research of autistic children.

c. to develop a better understanding of the problems of autistic children by the public, and to that end, to cooperate with all public, private and religious agencies

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d. to promote the education, training and recreation of autistic children and to foster the development of integrated programs in their behalf;

e. to promote the establishment of adequate educational and recreational facilities for autistic children;

f. to further the training and education of personnel for training, educating, and caring for autistic children;

g. to encourage the formation of parent groups, to advise and aid parents in the solution of their problems with autistic children and to coordinate the efforts and activities of these groups;

h. to serve as a clearing house for gathering and disseminating information regarding autistic children; and

i. to solicit and receive funds for the accomplishment of the above purposes

4. The separate existence of the constituent corporation, Westchester Exceptional Children, Inc., hereby ceases, and the surviving corporation is hereby vested with all the rights, privileges, immunities, powers and authority possessed by or granted by law to each of the constituent corporations. All assets and liabilities of the respective constituent corporations are hereby assets and liabilities of the surviving corporation. All property real, personal and mixed and all debts to each of the constituent corporations on whatever account are hereby attached to the surviving corporation and may be enforced against it to the same extent as if the debts, liabilities and duties had been incurred or contracted by it.


5. The Commissioner of Education is designated as the representative of the corporation upon whom process in any action or proceeding against it may be served.

6. The merger herein shall take effect immediately.

7. The merged corporation will operate under the absolute charter granted to The Westchester School for Special Children, the surviving corporation.

Granted, July 13, 2020 by the Board of Regents of The University of the State of New York, for and on behalf of the State Education Department, and executed under the seal of said University and recorded as Number 27,159.
