TENURE APPOINTMENT

The Board of Education has responsibility for granting tenure to members of the professional staff. The rights inherent in such an appointment are governed by statute.

All teachers and administrators who receive regular appointments for the first time in the district shall be placed on probation and may be granted tenure by the Board upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools after four years of continuous service if a satisfactory evaluation is received for the four years of continuous service.

Teachers who have been granted tenure in the same area or subject in another school district may be recommended for tenure in the Yonkers public school system after three years of probationary service provided a satisfactory evaluation is received for the three period.

Teachers who have earned tenure in a subject or area in the Yonkers public school system different from their current appointment may be recommended for tenure in their current appointment after a three period of probationary service provided that a satisfactory evaluation is received for the three period.

Administrators who are transferred to and accept appointment to a different tenure area may be granted tenure in the new tenure area by the Board upon the recommendation of the Superintendent upon completion of three years of probationary service in the new tenure area provided that a satisfactory evaluation is received for the three-year probationary period.

Any variation related to the recommendation or granting of tenure or eligibility for tenure shall be in accordance with the New York State Department of Education and the laws of the State of New York.
