**Rationale:**

Term: October 2024 – August 2025  
Amount: \$462,187  
Scope: This collaboration involves Westchester Community College (WCC) and the Yonkers Public Schools (YPS) working together to provide activities for Pathways in Technology Early College High School (P-TECH), Smart Scholars and Extended School Day/ School Violence Prevention Program students are given the opportunity to earn college level credits while attending high school.

Additionally, P-TECH teachers will have the chance to engage in professional learning communities with Westchester Community College academic faculty to align their courses with the college's degree programs. This collaboration involves the following schools: Saunders Trades and Technical, Charles E. Gorton High School, Riverside High School, Roosevelt High School – Early College Studies, Barack Obama School for Social Justice, and Yonkers Montessori Academy. The goal is to align curricula, learning targets and improves student outcomes for participating high schools.




