**Rationale:** This is for the preventative maintenance, cleaning, inspection and repair of the 108 boilers and burners in the District. In compliance with General Municipal Law 103, this contract was publicly advertised in June 2020. Bids were opened and read aloud in public on June 26, 2020. Two bids (including a \$100,000 contingency) were received: Ultimate Power at \$716,000.00 and The Metro Group at \$1,472,000.00. Ultimate Power has had this contract since 2011. The \$100,000 contingency built into this bid is to cover the unexpected outcomes of insurance inspections. Without the \$100,000 contingency the lowest bid is at \$616,000.00 which is lower by \$79,000 than the previous year's bid of \$695,000.00
