The New York State Education Department (NYSED) is pleased to inform you it has tentatively awarded **Yonkers City School District** a grant for the New York State Pathways in Technology Early College High School Program (NYS P-TECH) in the total amount of **\$2,700,000** to be spent across 7 years.

There are several steps remaining prior to final approval:

If your award receives final approval, you will receive a final approval notice from NYSED's Grants Finance Unit. **No work should be initiated until you receive final notice of approval of your award. All grants, regardless of type or dollar amount, are subject to further review, monitoring, and audit to ensure compliance. NYSED has the right to recoup funds if the approved activities are not performed and/or the funds are expended inappropriately.**
