GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS: Only those municipalities wishing to accrue the apportionment provided pursuant to Chapter 59 of the Laws of 2020 as revenue to the 2020-21 school year, and thereby reduce revenues in the 2021-22 school year by an equal amount, should complete and submit this form. No apportionment may be claimed on this form in excess of 309% of the deficit reduction assessment of December 1990 as determined by the Commissioner of Education pursuant to Chapter 947 of the Laws of 1990 plus the Net Gap Elimination Adjustment for 2010-11 plus the GAP Elimination Adjustment for 2011-12 or in excess of salary expenses incurred by the municipality for employees of the city school district between April 1, 2021 and June 30, 2021. An original copy of the required Board Resolution approved by the Mayor and one (1) completed copy of the form should be filed by the municipality on behalf of the city school district with the State Aid Unit not sooner than June 14, 2021 but not later than June 25, 2021. This application will be accepted based on date of postmark. If approved, the claimed apportionment will be paid in September 2021.

Chapter 59 of the Laws of 2020 provides an apportionment to city school districts for salary expenses incurred between April 1, 2021 and June 30, 2021 up to a maximum amount equal to the city school district's Deficit Reduction Assessment of December 1990 *plus* 209 percent of such amount for a city school district in a city with a population of more than 195,000 inhabitants and less than 219,000 inhabitants according to the latest federal census *plus* the Gap Elimination Adjustments for 2010-11 and 2011-12. Upon application, this apportionment is available to the city school district as revenue to the 2020-21 school year and may be used to offset any potential General Fund deficit as of June 30, 2021 resulting from the impact upon city revenues of the Deficit Reduction Assessment and the Gap Elimination Adjustments for 2010-11 and 2011-12. The apportionment will be paid in September 2021, and this amount will be deducted from the following payments in the following order: The Lottery apportionment followed by the fixed fall payments (October, November, December 2021, for the 2021-22 school year), followed by the district's payments to the Teacher's Retirement System. Any remainder will be deducted from the individualized payments due the district (January – June 2022 General Aid).

To apply for the apportionment the municipality and the city school district must complete and submit to the State Aid Unit one copy of the enclosed Form SA-1, "Application and Claim for an Apportionment Pursuant to Chapter 59 of the Laws of 2020," not sooner than June 14, 2021 but not later than June 25, 2021. Applications will be accepted based on the date of postmark. The application must be accompanied by an original copy of the Board Resolution approved by the Mayor. Both the appropriate fiscal officer of the municipality and of the city school district should sign the form.
