<b>Rationale:</b>	<p>RFB 6822 was opened on July 22, 2022 with two bidders responding. FM Generator, Inc. is the incumbent vendor and has an acceptable history with the District.</p> <p>This subject contract covers the 12 schools with emergency power facilities. There are also provisions for performing owner directed additional work on a requirements basis at contract unit prices. It is renewable annually under mutual agreement for up to two additional years.</p> <p>This is 40% more than last year due to an increase cost in materials and the scope of work by the District.</p> <p>The students and staff of Schools: William Boyce Thompson School, Paideia School 15, Martin Luther King Jr. Academy, Cesar E. Chavez School, Enrico Fermi School, Yonkers Montessori Academy, Riverside High School, Lincoln High School, Yonkers Middle High School, Saunders High School, Las Hermanas Mirabal Community School and Montessori School 31.</p>




