The preschool schedule includes special programming such as animal science from the Green Burgh Nature Center, Music and Movement with Mr. Zev and Art with Ms. Kathy.

Four times a year every quarter, (fall, winter, spring, and summer) teachers complete a formative assessment for students. The results of the assessment are used to inform teachers of students' strengths and weaknesses. These assessments are also communicated with parents during quarterly parent-teacher conferences to discuss students' results and progress. In addition, annual reports/ assessments will be shared with the Yonkers School district.
