The curriculum reflects updated input from teachers, is aligned with the NYS Social Studies Framework, and includes inquiry investigations using the four dimensions of the C3 inquiry model found in the NYS Toolkit. The curriculum is also aligned to the Next Generation English Language Arts Learning Standards and features virtual instruction recommendations, updated resources for teaching in the virtual, blended and hybrid learning environments and equity considerations.
