Dear Dr. Luis Rodriguez,

Thank you for helping us to complete another successful school year at the Learning Center at Four Winds Hospital. Students from your school received inpatient psychiatric services at the Hospital.

As part of their program, a staff of twelve teachers, certified in elementary, secondary and/or special education, provided tutorial services at the Learning Center, in a school-like setting located in a separate building on the Hospital campus. Each child and adolescent patient participates in our tutorial program in small groups of 5 to 7 students for two hours daily. Our tutorial rate for the 2020-2021 school year will be sixty dollars per hour (\$60.00).

The Learning Center at Four Winds Hospital is designed to provide an educational component as part of the individual treatment plan for those patients in need of academics. School involvement during psychiatric treatment helps provide part of the student's normal daily routine and aids in continuing educational growth. With written permission, contact with the home district ensures an educational continuum. Subject matter is designed to closely follow the current school syllabus from the patient's home school and is specifically tailored to the individual academic level of the student. Students are able to complete regents and local exams while being treated at Four Winds Hospital.

At discharge from the hospital, The Learning Center instructor will prepare a final written report notifying the home-school district of pertinent information regarding that student, including recommendations for continued successful learning.

We take pride in working with your students. Our teaching staff understands the value that a positive high quality educational experience plays in a student's hospital treatment and in helping them make a positive transition back to school upon discharge.
