Interpreters/translators previously assigned to a particular school will be given priority to the assignments. If a previously assigned interpreter is not available, we will contact the school and discuss any rate changes involved.

Assignments are made by area whenever possible. If an interpreter/translator who accepts lower rates is available for an assignment, the adjusted rate will be charged.

Rates will also be taken into consideration for written translations when assigned to translator.

Most interpreters/translators require a 3-hour minimum per assignment. Some interpreters/translators charge per half day or full day. Travel time may be charged depending on the language—we will contact the school to discuss any travel costs that may be incurred.

Telephone calls to parents and/or students for informational purposes only or arrangements for future meetings will be charged:

Spanish: up to ½ hour—\$80.00.

Other Languages: up to ½ hour—\$100.00

Telephone calls over 30 minutes will be charged full rate.

Written translations will be a \$50.00 minimum (240 words or less) or \$.18 per word for Spanish including certification of document if required. Other languages may vary depending on the language and availability of translator. In this instance we will advise your office of the approximate cost before translation is started. Documents will be certified, if necessary.

All Invoices presented to the school district are based on the interpreters and translators' invoices. As mentioned above, we adjust the Invoice accordingly to the final Interpreter's Invoice.

A cancellation fee of \$100.00 for Spanish Interpreters will be imposed if the interpreter is cancelled less than twenty-four (24) hours of appearance. Cancellation fee for other languages will vary depending on individual language and will be Invoiced accordingly to the final Interpreter's Invoice.
