Rebound is full-day program that offers academic support, electives, and clinical services at The Guidance Center of Westchester, located at 256 Washington Street, Mount Vernon.

Students in Rebound receive support to get current with their academic subjects while addressing their mental health and/or substance use issues. After completing Rebound, students return to their schools and are on track for promotion or graduation.

Who will benefit from Rebound?

Students ages 16-21 who are struggling in school due to mental health and/or substance use issues.

What will students do in Rebound?

Each morning, students participate in 2 hours of online Apex learning tutorials under the supervision of a special education teacher. In the afternoon, students take part in 1 hour of mental health and/or substance use services. Individual, group, and family counseling services are available.

Electives include topics such as work readiness, college prep, and entrepreneurship.

Breakfast and lunch are provided daily.

How much does it cost?

The academic support program is based on the school district home and hospital tuition rate of \$120 per student per day. Mental health and substance use services are billed through the student's Medicaid or private insurance.
