We are delighted to offer the web-based Integrated Social Studies/ELA Curriculum for Grades K-8. Currently, over 250 districts in New York State are using the program. The curriculum reflects updated input from teachers, is aligned with the NYS Social Studies Framework, and includes inquiry investigations using the four dimensions of the C3 inquiry model found in the NYS Toolkit. The curriculum is also aligned to the Next Generation English Language Arts Learning Standards and features virtual instruction recommendations, updated resources for teaching in the virtual, blended and hybrid learning environments and equity considerations.

 - Lessons are aligned with the unifying themes and NYS Framework for Social Studies including key concepts, Social Studies standards and Social Studies practices.
